## **Recommendation/Conclusions**

• Review of AIA By-laws; Aritcle 25 – Soccer Committee by consensus recommended the following changes

ARTICLE 25 SOCCER

### Present Bylaw

25.1.4 Varsity regular season, Region tournament and Post-Season tournament progression soccer games, which are tied after the completion of regulation play, shall be resolved in the following manner: Theteams shall play two ten-minute overtime periods. If the game is still tied after the two ten-minuteovertime periods, the winner shall be determined by the Procedures to Determine the Winner of a Matchas outlined in 25.1.5.

### **Recommended deletion**

25.1.4 Varsity regular season, Region tournament and Post-Season tournament progression soccer games, which are tied after the completion of regulation play, shall be resolved in the following manner: Theteams shall play two ten-minute overtime periods. If the game is still tied after the two ten-minuteovertime periods, the winner shall be determined by the Procedures to Determine the Winner of a Matchas outlined in 25.1.5.

### **25.4 SCHEDULES**

### Present Bylaw

25.4.1 Each Region will develop its own schedule as provided for in the AIA Bylaws.

25.4.1.1 Boys and Girls - 1A/2A/3A Conference schools shall be allowed to schedule and qualify for the post-season tournament in either the 4A or 5A Conference.

25.4.2 In the absence of a master schedule, a school must have a regularly organized program to qualify for the post-season tournament. (See Article 12)

25.4.3 If scheduling difficulties occur, schedules may be increased by one game. The additional game shall be approved by the AIA Executive Board.

### **Recommended deletion/change**

25.4.1 Each Region will develop its own schedule as provided for in the AIA Bylaws. Add language that is consistent with all team sports.

25.4.1.1 Boys and Girls 1A/2A/3A Conference schools shall be allowed to schedule and qualify for the post season tournament in either the 4A or 5A Conference.

### **25.5 NUMBER OF GAMES IN SEASON**

### **Present Bylaw**

25.5.2 No school shall schedule more than eight junior varsity or freshman games per team.

25.5.2.1 EXCEPTION: No 1A/2A/3A Conference school shall schedule more than 13 junior varsity or freshman games per team.

25.5.2.2 EXCEPTION: No 4A/5A Conference school shall schedule more than 12 junior varsity or freshman games per team.

### **Recommended deletion/change**

25.5.2 No school shall schedule more than eight 12 junior varsity or freshman games per team.

25.5.2.1 EXCEPTION: No 1A/2A/3A Conference school shall schedule more than 13 junior varsity or freshman games per team.

25.5.2.2 EXCEPTION: No 4A/5A Conference school shall schedule more than 12 junior varsity or freshman games per team.

### Present Bylaw

25.5.3.1 EXCEPTION: 1A/2A/3A Conference schools, because of their limited enrollment, may permit a player to participate in an unlimited number of games per season, excluding qualifying and post-season tournaments.

### **Recommended deletion/change**

25.5.3.1 EXCEPTION: 1A/2A/3A Conference Division III & Division IV schools, because of their limited enrollment, may permit a player to participate in an unlimited number of games per season, excluding qualifying and post-season tournaments, to fill teams at the junior varsity or freshman levels.

### **25.9 POST-SEASON TOURNAMENTS**

### Present By-law

25.9.1 Region Tournaments

25.9.1.1 Regional qualifiers for the post season tournament shall be determined by each Conference.

### **Recommended change**

#### 25.9.1 Tie Breaker Procedures

- 1. Head to Head (Regular season)
- 2. Overall Record (Regular season percentage)
- 3. Total Opponent Victory Points
- 4. Mini Playoff (If needed to get into the tournament)
- 2011-12 Divisions and Sectionals are found on the AIA website.
- 2011-12 Reconfiguration State Qualifying Procedures for Soccer -16 team tournaments

-Three sections will qualify three teams in each division based on their power ranking within their section

- The nine automatic qualifiers, plus seven at-large qualifiers, will make up the 16-team state tournament and be seeded according to their power ranking.

2011 Winter State Tournament information was shared with the group. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> round tournament games for all classifications (1A-5A) will be played at Reach 11, Red Mountain Park, Tucson, Yuma, and potentially Flagstaff. The location will be determined by the highest seeded team.
