The committee nominated and unanimously approved Dave Smithers as the chairman of the swimming sport advisory committee.

The committee reviewed the new changes for the 2011 swim season:

- 32 individuals will qualify for the state meet instead of 24. The number of relay teams to qualify will remain at 24.
- A sanctioned qualifying meet must meet the following criteria: Electronic timing, 5 certified officials, minimum of 5 teams, and submit a qualifying meet form, prior to and after the meet.
- Each school will use Hy-tek Team Manager Software. Tam Manager Lite is a free version of the software.
- A “invitational weekend” will be blacked out one week prior to the state meet for competition opportunities.
- The 2011 State Swimming Meet will take place over 2 days, with 2 sessions using 2 pools on prelim Friday and 1 session using 2 pools on finals Saturday. Saturday’s session would start at 12:00 noon.
- New 2011 Standards have been set and approved by the committee.
- Only 11 dive programs can qualify for the state meet.
- Any diver that meets an 11-dive provisional qualifying score at an invitational may enter the **State Dive Qualifier meet to be held on October 20/21, 2011.** From that meet **32** divers will qualify for the State Meet in each division.

Invitational calendar was reviewed and any changes to 2011 meets need to be made soon so coach’s can plan for next year.

2011 standards were passed out for review. By unanimous approval of the committee the 2011 swim & dive standards were approved.
