Action Items:

- Motion by Pat Witter (Buckeye) and seconded by Andie Richie (Youngker) to elect Larry Boyles (Horizon) as chairman of golf committee, Motion Passed.

- Discussion on State Tournament Qualifying Score Standards for the upcoming season. Because the Division III schools are still playing the number was left as is except adding two strokes to the team qualifying number. The committee wanted to be consistent by adding four strokes to all the team Target Scores.

A concern was brought up from Brian Cornelius from NW Christian regarding the correct course rating being used by the Division III schools, as well as how the Female golfers on the Coed teams for spring are calculated.

Dean Visser responded by stating that the course ratings for the men's tees can be found by clicking on the golf course name and then matching the tees and the nine holes used. For those schools that have female golfers, they can use any of the forward tees and then calculate the course rating using the Arizona Women's Golf Association web site. The girls must still shoot the target score plus 6 or less, just like the boys, however, the yardage distance at the State tournament will be calculated at 85% of the boy's yardage.

The committee members and guests broke up into groups by geographic areas to work on next year's girl's golf schedules. The committee also recommended through the scheduling process to have open dates for either a City or District type Tournament toward the end of the season.
