SCOTTSDALE CHAPARRAL VS LAS VEGAS BISHOP GORMAN SQUARE OFF IN SOLLENBERGER CLASSIC AT UNIVERSITY OF PHOENIX STADIUM

Arizona Interscholastic Association football returns to FOX Sports Arizona this Fall with a 10-game schedule featuring some of the best teams, rivalries and players Arizona high school football has to offer. In addition to regular season action, FOX Sports Arizona will also televise the AIA's Division I and Division II Championship games on Nov. 26.

It all kicks off this Saturday, Aug. 20, with the Sollenberger Classic live from University of Phoenix Stadium. This special game features AIA Division II pre-season favorite Scottsdale Chaparral versus Nevada's perennial high school power Las Vegas Bishop Gorman. FOX Sports Arizona will produce this game that will air also air nationally on FSN regional sports networks. Coverage begins at 7:30 p.m.

In addition to Saturday's Chaparral/Bishop Gorman match-up, two other FOX Sports Arizona productions will also be seen nationwide as part of FSN's National High School Football Game of the Week schedule – Hamilton/Notre Dame on Sept. 9 and Chandler/Basha on Sept. 15. Additional national telecasts could be added at a later date.
