# Soccer Advisory Committee Minutes February 22, 2012 AIA Boardroom

Minutes from August 30, 2011 meeting:

Motion to approve by Jeff Penzone, seconded by Joe Paddock, approved

### Discussion items:

- With preliminary counts attendance is up from last year.
- Had good feedback with high seeds 1-4 hosting two games.
- Committee suggested we have 2 ½ hours between games at the semi-final level.
- Finals at Campo Verde went well great attendance

### Results of committee survey to coaches:

- 193 responses from coaches, 53% girls coaches, 47% boys coaches
- Regarding the 5 scheduled home & away opponents 25% liked it, 32% want 6 home & away, 16% want to schedule less home & away, 27% want no home & away games
- On the 16 team state tournament 24% said keep it, 52% want to expand it to 24, 21% want to expand it to 32, 3% said allow everyone in
- Would you support requiring a minimum number of games played with in your section 11% said no, 35% said 6 games, 29% said 8 games, 25% said 10 games or more
- What is your view on tie games 42% keep current system, 22% split power points after regulation, 19% split power points after overtime, 15% do shootout and award 2/3 of points to shootout winner and ½ points to shootout loser.
- What is your view on Regional/Sectional tournaments 33% keep current system, 52% reinstate regional/sectional tournaments, 7% do all qualifying for state be regional/sectional tournaments, 8% other
- What is your view on the number of games 47% keep it at 14 including 2 tournaments, 28% change it to 14 power point games, 8% up it to 18 games starting before Thanksgiving, 18% up it to 18 games ending after President's day.

- What is your view on divisional/sectional alignment 18% keep it the same, 44% minimal changes are needed, 38% change it drastically
- The optimum size of a section for soccer is 17% said 17-20 schools, 33% said 13-16 schools, 41% said 10-12 schools, 9% other
- Referees evaluation and selection 13% keep it the same, 70% allow coaches to review officials and have some input into playoff selections, 16% change it drastically
- Referees fitness 14% referees fitness allows them to cover the whole field and be effective, 36% said referee fitness is a small problem, 21% say the referee fitness prevents them from doing their job at an acceptable level, 28% say referee fitness is affecting games
- Referees professionalism 1% are all professional, 24% almost all are professional, 49% most are professional, 25% a few are professional, 0% non are professional
- What are your thoughts on the fields that games are played on 0% thought fields are great, 56% said most fields are acceptable, 27% said most fields are poor and lead to injuries, 16% say field are overall poor.

# Scheduling:

- The committee discussed saving travel vs. competition, power points and limited playing season
- Discussed that schools can change their schedule (different opponent, double headers, etc) during the period that is open for changes.
- Concern by 1A/2A/3A coaches competing in Division III. The option is open to Division IV in the fall.
- The committee had a power point presentation by Westview administrators on a scheduling option

## All Section/Division selection:

• Coaches can and are encouraged to meet within your section or division. Voting must be done online.

## Player limit at state tournament:

• There is a game management issue with sidelines during state tournament games and the number of personnel on the field.

#### Committee recommendations:

- 1. That schools schedule separate opponents within their section and division.
- 2. In lieu of the two year block in scheduling increase the number of teams qualifying for the state tournament from 16 to 24. (motion by Jeannine Brandel 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pat Andrew, passed)
- 3. That schools in the state tournament be limited to 30 players in uniform and only district certified coaches on the sideline. (motion by Jeff Penzone 2<sup>nd</sup> by Michael Wakeford, passed)
