Action Items:

- Distance Measuring Devices Verification Form.

Dean Visser provided the members with a sample form for verifying distance measuring devices. The form includes school name, the rule (**USGA 14-3**) concerning range finders and **AIA Bylaws: Article 24 Golf**, and the coach's signature. Discussion followed and Dean will be making some small revisions to the form and following AIA legal approval it will be posted on the AIA website. - Schedules for 2012-2013

Discussion followed on how this would affect scheduling and how it could enhance student recognition. This subject will be discussed further at the next meeting.
