REFPAY FUNDING & BALANCE!

Please make sure your school's RefPay is sufficiently funded to finish out any pending Officials' payments for Spring sports and tournaments.

Many officials are *still waiting for payment*!! These officials cannot be paid until the account is funded.

If the account shows a low balance, it still may not be enough for the final payments. Please assess your RefPay account and year end needs.

YEAR END OPTIONS for RefPay accounts:

- 1. Leave account balance as is until Fall funding.
- 2. Request a check to zero account until Fall funding.
 - Must be done via email to Denise
 Doser <u>ddoser@aiaonline.org</u>
 - State the school name on the account to be refunded.
 - Check will be forwarded to school.
- Deposit additional funds to have on account for Fall pre-funding
