Pre-Meet Coaches Meeting

Swim Team Coaches Pre-Meet Coaches Meeting: There will be a head swim coaches meeting on **Wednesday, November 5, 2014**. The meeting will start at **7:00 p.m. at the AIA office**. Coach and swimmer credentials will be distributed at this meeting.

Notes:

- In the preliminaries and finals, the **Boys** will compete first.
- The name of the diving coach must be listed on the team information credential request form that the head coach for each school is required to complete for deck credential lists.
- Awards will be presented immediately following each Championship final.

Division I / Division II

Deck Credential Distribution

Credentials will be distributed at the **head swim coaches** meeting on **Wednesday, November 5, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at the AIA Office**.

When coaches, swimmers and divers arrive at the pool facility, they must have their credentials clearly visible around their neck to receive admittance and (except when swimming/diving) to be on the deck.

Head coaches who cannot attend the coaches pre-meet meeting, may pick up their credential packet beginning at 7:45 a.m. (Friday) morning of prelims at the team entrance.

- Athletes and coaches, please review the time schedule for each Division listed on page 4 and 5 of this document for check-in times.

All dive coaches/divers will receive their deck credentials when they check in on site. Dive check in will be at the lobby entrance of Skyline Aquatic Center.

STATE MEET

INDIVIDUAL AND RELAY ENTRY PROCEDURE

1. All Division I and Division II individual swimming and relay entries, for the AIA State Meet, shall be submitted online at www.maxpreps.com .
2. Division I and Division II swimming entries (including relays):
 - The www.maxpreps.com website will open for individual and relay entries on Sunday, October 26, 2014 and will remain open for entries until **6:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 2, 2014.**
3. Directions for coaches to utilize MaxPreps online entry process will be found on the swim & dive page of www.aiaonline.org, under coaches.
4. Dive coaches must submit entries for the State Dive Qualifier. (See pages 9-10)

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS – All Participating Teams

Before the Meet

- Qualifiers by event sheets for the AIA Division I and II, State Swim & Dive Preliminaries and Championships will be available on the brackets section of the AIA website, Tuesday the week of the state meet.
- For up-to-date information about the meet, check the updated information in the 2013 AIA State Swim & Dive Tournament Guide on the Coaches page of www.aiaonline.org .
- Heat sheets will be provided to coaches at the Friday/Saturday coaches meeting.

During the Meet

- Rules shall be those of the current edition of the NFHS Swimming & Diving Rule Book, the AIA Constitution and Bylaws, and these tournament instructions.
- The Skyline Aquatic Center prohibits food and drinks on the pool deck. Do not plan to bring coolers filled with food and drinks on the deck. NO GLASS containers may be brought on the pool deck or into the spectator seating areas.
- Small dressing rooms will be available. There are no lockers or towels provided for participants in this meet.
- Changing into or out of swimsuits outside designated locker room areas by athletes at any level of competition is prohibited at AIA Sanctioned Events. Prohibited areas include but are not limited to, team and spectator seating sections, as well as warm-up and competition pool decks.
- Neither the AIA nor the host site is responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- In order to provide swimmers and divers with the best possible competitive environment, admission to the deck will be limited to credentialed athletes, coaches and meet officials. The following rules will apply to the deck passes:
 - All individual and relay qualifiers (swimming and diving) will automatically receive credentials.

Note: Team Head Coach must submit Coaches Deck Credential Form to **Ron Halbach, AIA State Tournament Coordinator**, by **October 24, 2014. (rhalbach@aiaonline.org)**

- *Misuse of credentials will result in confiscation and ejection of the non-participant swimmer/coach from the swimming meet facility.*
- In each race the **Boys** will compete first followed by the **Girls**.
- Awards will be as noted in the AIA Constitution and Bylaws. The Division I & Division II awards for swimming and diving will be presented on deck immediately following each Championship final.
- No chairs are available at the state tournament site.
- No commercial tents (large rented tents installed by outside vendors) will be permitted.
- Portable, non-commercial, tents will be permitted.

Relay Entries

- National Federation Swimming Rule Book, 3.2.3., in relay events, 8 individuals may be designated and it shall **not** count as an entry unless the competitor actually competes in the event. Any of the 8 individuals may swim in the prelims, swim-offs and/or finals, provided he/she does not exceed the permitted entries for the meet.

TO ADVANCE TO THE STATE SWIM & DIVE CHAMPIONSHIPS, A DIVER MUST ATTEND AND FINISH IN THE TOP 32 AT THE STATE DIVING QUALIFIER

ENTRANTS: Divers must meet the Provisional standard for their division to be entered into the State Diving Qualifier.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Sunday October 26th, 3:00 pm. *No late entries can be made, the website will automatically close the meet at the deadline.*

Dive coaches must adhere to the following entry instructions to get their divers into the State Diving Qualifier.

State Dive Qualifier Entry Instructions:

We are using CleanEntries.com for State Qualifiers and State Championships this year. Please note that the first time you sign up, it will not be a fast process as all your divers need to sign up too. After you go through the setup process the first time, you will not need to setup again for subsequent meets. You will just enter dive sheets.

1. Go to <https://cleanentries.com/> to login or create an account if you are new to the site. If this is your first time registering you will need to add your team to the database. Please use the official name of your team when entering the full team name, and your 4-letter AIA school code for the abbreviated code. Codes can be found on the AIA website or the AZ High School Diving Coaches Facebook group.
2. Once you have set up your team, have your divers create their own accounts and choose your school as their team.
3. Find our meet, AZ State Diving Qualifier, and follow the on-screen instructions for entering each diver's sheet.
4. Please be sure to enter your divers' sheets accurately. Your athletes may also log in and check their sheets, but only coaches can make changes.

AIA has a Media Credential Policy that needs to be followed to protect the proprietary rights of the Association and to protect the student-athletes and coaches at region and state tournament events. The following link (http://aiaonline.org/news/press_center.php) is to the AIA Media Center which houses the AIA Media Credential Form and the AIA Approved Media List (those that have requested and been granted AIA media credentials). Please download the AIA Media Credential Form and should a media member need access that is not on the media list, they will need to sign off on the form. Please print out several of the Media Credential Forms so each media outlet fills out its own form. Should the media member refuse to sign off on the form, they will not be granted access to the region or state tournament event you're hosting.

At the conclusion of the event, please fax or mail those forms to the AIA so that we may follow up and credential those people the approved media list will be updated as forms are received and processed. Please download the AIA Approved Media List (which is constantly being updated) so that those members of the media that are already approved may be granted access. Please note that some members of the media might show up with Freelance Credentials. These have no pictures on them, but do allow for access to the event per the designated media outlet on the AIA Media Credential.
