23.5.3 No player shall participate in more than ten football games per season, excluding qualifying and post-season tournaments.

23.5.3.1 EXCEPTION: Division V & VI schools, because of their limited enrollment, may permit a player to participate in an unlimited number of football games per season, excluding qualifying and post-season tournaments.

23.5.3.2 EXCEPTION: Division IV schools, because of their limited enrollment, may permit a player to participate in 50% more matches or games than the regularly scheduled matches or games per season, excluding qualifying and post-season tournaments.

Example: If a school scheduled 20 games or matches, each player could participate in 50% more games or matches for a total of 30.

Note: The AIA Sport Medicine Advisory Committee, at the request of the AIA Executive Board, is looking at the two exceptions to AIA bylaw; article 23.5.3 regarding the increased opportunity for concussions and other injuries that these two bylaws create for student athletes.

14.3.2.2 A junior varsity team shall be limited to 9th, 10th and 11th grade students, with the exception of the 1A Conference.
