February 18, 2014 March 17, 2014 April 21, 2014 After further consideration and discussion the AIA Executive Board determined that any aftermarket helmet sensor devices will <u>not</u> be prohibited from use as per the News Release of 4 September 2013 and will <u>not</u> be considered a violation of NFHS Football Rule 1.5.1. AIA member schools will have the opportunity to determine the value and efficacy of such devices (e.g. Shockbox) and their use in furthering a healthy and safe environment for those participating in football.
