> WRESTING SANITATION POLICY

- Dr. Wilson presented the committee with general guidelines that Dave Hayward helped put together.
- Recommendations would be to have showers available to the athletes.
- Tamara McLeod made a motion to approve the Section 3: Equipment Sanitation Requirements to policy.
 - o Seconded by Michael Lavoie and Randy Cohen*
 - The policy will be presented for formal approval by the Executive Board at the April meeting.

PROPOSAL: BAGS & DUMMIES

- The committee discussed the use of bags and dummies for off season football.
- Randy Cohen stated that he was in favor of the policy as they do allow use at the collegiate level.
- The committee encourages the training of the Heads Up Football program as a way of injury prevention.
 - The thought behind the use of the bags and dummies for off season football is to allow the use in an effort to increase skill before regular seasons begin.
 - If this policy is created there would need to be specifics as to what can be used and how it can be used.
- Specific restrictions must be implemented.
 - The committee felt if a coach had gone through the training of the Heads UP program that school would be allowed to use bags/dummies for specific trainings.
 - o Heads Up training would be a requirements before any consideration would
- The committee has asked a member of the football sports advisory committee to be present at the March meeting.
 - o They've also asked for the SAC to provided language regarding the use of bags/dummies.
