

AACCA Safety Certification Course
&
NFHS Rules Interpretation Course

Registration Process

The following **required courses** will be held at the **AIA office** located at
7007 N. 18th St. (NW corner of the SR51 & Glendale Ave.), unless noted otherwise.

**** NOTICE....A school's Spiritline team will NOT be allowed to stunt, tumble or compete during the season of activity until ALL Spiritline/Cheer/Pom coaches (paid or volunteer, head coach, assistant coach, varsity, JV, Freshman, etc.) are AACCA Safety Certified (with proof provided) and the coaches have attended a NFHS Spirit Rules Interpretation Course. (Coaches are to take the two required courses through the AIA).**

CHANGES FOR 2016-2017 SEASON

A Coaches Conference will be held not only providing the NFHS AIA Rules and AACCA, but other courses and chances for coaches to network

Renewing coaches can take their NFHS Rules Course through a webinar and renew their AACCA through the AACCA website

Newly Hired Coaches (did not take any courses through the AIA for the 2016-2017 season) **MUST** take their courses **in-person, through the AIA**-NO EXCEPTIONS

- **AACCA Safety Certification** is valid for **FOUR YEARS (Cost: \$75)**

- This course may be taken online (www.nfhslearn.com) **only if the following criteria is met:**
 - o Spiritline coach is renewing certification and has taken the course prior through the AIA.

*** NOTE: ALL NEWLY HIRED coaches (non-renewal) MUST attend the course in person through the AIA.**

- **NFHS Spirit Rules Course** must be taken **EVERY YEAR (Cost: FREE)**

- This course will be taken online through a webinar **only if the following criteria is met:**
 - o Spiritline coach attended the NFHS Spirit Rules Course in 2010 through the AIA.

*** NOTE: ALL NEWLY HIRED coaches (non-renewal) MUST attend the course in person through the AIA.**

**** NOTE: All Spiritline coaches MUST also take the NFHS Concussions in Sports FREE online course at www.nfhslearn.com **** (This is a one time completion course)

In person classes at the AIA office are limited to 70 participants for the NFHS Spirit Rules Course for the AACCA course. Admission will be granted to those who register first. Online webinars are limited to 70 participants as well. Make sure you put a 2nd choice. Classes can fill up before the online registration closes. A confirmation email will come about 1-2 weeks before the class.

What to do:

1. Find a date that is good for you to take the AACCA Safety Certification Course and/or the NFHS Spirit Rules Interpretation Course. (*Keep in mind that your team will **NOT** be allowed to stunt/tumble or compete (from the first week of permissive football-August 1) until ALL Spiritline coaches have taken the two required courses and completed the Concussions in Sports online course.*)

3. **EMAIL** your Purchase Order to spirit@aiaonline.org by the **DEADLINE DATE**.
**** NOTE: You will NOT be allowed to register AFTER THE DEADLINE DATE POSTED FOR EACH SESSION ****
4. **PAYMENT:** Please bring payment with you on the COURSE DATE (**DO NOT MAIL PAYMENT**)
5. **NOTE:** If you are already AACCA Safety Certified, you will just need to supply a copy of your certification to your Athletic Director and take the NFHS Spirit Rules Course **ONLY**.
6. A confirmation email will be sent to each registered coach with more details **after each deadline**.

**(AACCA Safety Certification is valid for FOUR YEARS;
NFHS Rules Course must be taken ANNUALLY, EVERY CALENDAR SCHOOL YEAR)**
