- Before coaches split to vote, discussion was had on the decision by the AIA to not count
  the region tournament games as power point games. The 1A Conference had decided
  that region tournaments would count for power points. The AIA gave all regions the
  option to choose to hold a region tournament. All regions knew that if they chose to
  not hold a region tournament they would miss out on some power points. There was
  some obvious frustration expressed by the coaches and AD's. Some schools were right
  on the border of making the playoffs or not.
- After discussion on the power point issue, the football and volleyball coaches split to make their all-region selections.

B. Section Tournaments This Year

Volleyball – How did it go, \$ report from host schools

- For the North, Greyhills made over \$600 at the gate. Referees were \$500. After paying staff, it was a loss. For the Central, the crowd was not huge at Joseph City. The gate was \$260.
- Discussion was heard regarding changing to a 6 team tournament (or even a 4 team) instead of an eight team tournament in the Central Region. This would cut down on cost and allow all of the tournament to be held at one location on one day. Most appeared in favor, however, no vote was taken and the plan is to discuss the topic at a later meeting.

Basketball - What about a Super-Regional together – Feb. 7-11 Who will host

- The North Region had already voted on combining with the Central Region for a superregional tournament. The top 4 teams would be taken from each region and the money would be split in half. Greyhills would be the host school (their gym seats 4500 and would be free to use).
- Most seemed to be in favor, however there is a worry that the basketball region tournament will not count for power points. If no power points will be awarded, it will not be worth it to some. No official vote was held until the power point issue is figured out.

Trophy for Region Tournament Champion?

- All agreed that we should provide a trophy for the region tournament champion but no
  decision was made as to how to pay for this. There is the possibility of making some
  profit off of our region basketball tournament. We are unsure as to whether or not we
  will be able to keep a checking account in the regions name. Mr. Echeverria will look in
  to the possibilities.
- We also discussed meeting a week before the region tournament (or the morning of the regional tournament) to be able to vote for all-region teams. This would allow for all the awards to be presented at the tournament. Future meetings will be set with this in mind.
