➤ **WRESTLING ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

- Members approved the Wrestling safety banner with minor corrections. Motion moved by Dr. Wilson. No Discussion.

➤ **PRE-CONTEST EMERGENCY TIMEOUT UPDATE (Kristina Wilson)**

- Take the proposal to Gary Whelchel for review & possibly make a card with Pre-Contest Medical Preparedness and/or Education.
- Committee proposed asking the 4 major questions before each contest:
 - Is there a health provider on site?
 - Is there an AED on site?
 - Where is the EAP (Emergency Action Plan) located?
 - Where does EMS enter onto site/school?

➤ **OPIATE EDUCATION UPDATE (Javier Cardenas)**

- Dr. Cardenas discussed Maricopa County wanting to educate parents and students on opiate education.

➤ **AT CONSENT TO TREAT (Mark Mignella)**

- Mark Mignella brought up the proposal that an ATC can have a consent form in place for post season events. Implement a plan to have member schools add this form to Parental Packets. Member schools will also be responsible to sign off & school ATC must be aware of the consent form.
 - Other options for member schools who require Register My Athlete; to include the consent form pack of that online packet.

- **COLLABORATIVE SOLUTIONS OF SPORT SAFETY (David Hines)**
 - David Hines updated the committee on Excursion Sickle Cell & treatment, lightning policies & educational strategies,
 - David Hines also discussed the EAP (Emergency Action Plan) including heat and clearance.
 - The committee asked “Who has responsibility of the EAP at larger venues for post season events”?

- **KSI ANALYSIS OF AIA HEALTH POLICIES (Javier Cardenas)**
 - Dr. Cardenas asked committee is the EAP would be sport & site specific?
 - A checklist should be implemented for each site.
 - Updating protocols and reviewing the EAP will be the main topics at the next SMAC meeting.
