      - Baseball max of 20 games (18 pp & 2 Invites), minimum of 14 games
      - Softball max of 20 games (18 pp & 2 Invites), minimum of 14 games
    - Individual Sports have nothing entered. Each sport is up to the individual AD to set their schedule.

The winner of the play-in games advance to the state tournament. The bracket will be seeded 1-16 based on powerpoints. The play-in games will be played on Oct. 29<sup>th</sup>.
    - o Basketball-same format as volleyball. The play-in games will be Feb. 11<sup>th</sup>.

- Baseball/Softball-just like football. 8 region champs automatically qualify and will be the home team unless they play another region champ with a higher seed. The other 8 seeds will be the next highest ranked teams according to powerpoints. Bracket will be seeded 1-16 based on powerpoints.

- Transfer Rule
  - A student is allowed one transfer (domicile changes no longer matter, they would be filed as hardships) without having to sit a full year. With the first transfer, the student has to sit out half of the regular season contests. It excludes tournaments. AD's do have the option if they feel like a hardship has occurred to fast track the process through a new form on the AIA website. Any subsequent transfer will cost them the entire season.

  - 530 Form if Student didn't participate in sports at former school
    - Hard copy-fill out and either scan or fax between schools and then to the AIA offices.

      - Fast track form is found on your AIA portal homepage under Hardship Approvals. It's a link to a PDF form.
