> OPIATE EDUCATION (David Hines)

- David Hines updates the committee on a new partnership with SweetRush Company, who will be developing a learning program for opiate education.
 - The SweetRush tool will be a 60 min tool with frame by frame questions. If a student gets an answer incorrect, the student must redo the frame.
- The AIA will review the program with the Maricopa County and the Arizona Governor's office. Estimates review by October 2019.

> HEAT RELATED ILLNESS/USE OF RECTAL THERMOMETER (David Hayward)

- Committee discuss the use of rectal thermometers during potential heat related incidents.
- Tamara McLeod and her team will be working on a survey to gather information from high schools during heat related practice & competition.

> <u>REVIEW OF HEAT POLICY</u>

- Dr. Cardenas goes over AIA Article 41 with the committee.
- Committee recommends additional resources be available to the public under Heat/Heart/Head tabs on AIA website.
 - 80% of deaths occur during heat related activities & the more education out to the public would help decrease these stats.
 - Tamara strongly recommends under the "Return to Play" policy that step by step instructions for athletic trainers and administrators; which would include and not limited to hydration strategies. This addition would be added 41.3 and 41.4; once approved by the Executive Board.

> <u>REVIEW OF CONCUSSION POLICY</u>

• Dr. Cardenas and committee review the concussion policy and approves of policy.

REVIEW OF EAP POLICY

• The committee reviews Article 41.6.2 and recommends a verbiage change. This change will be up for review at the next Executive Board meeting; August 2019.

REVIEW OF ADDITIONAL SPORTS MEDICINE POLICIES

- In this review, the committee discusses if there should be a Cardiac Arrest Policy?
- Under Article 17.1.2, the committee recommends to add the language "current" to First Aid & CRP certification.
 - Steve Erickson will tackle this project and language.
- The Transgender Article since the last update is approved.
 - The committee also discusses the Lightning Policy and the NFHS current rules.
 - SMAC recommends to add "and QMP when present" to policy.
