> **OPIATE EDUCATION**

- The English version of the Opiate Education Course has been completed. They are currently working on the Spanish version.
- Course takes about 25-30 minutes to complete
- Only requiring students to complete once during high school.
 - Encourage parents / coaches to take the course as well
 - \circ The school has the option to require the students to take it more than once.
- Item will be brought to the Executive Board during the February meeting for approval into the Policies and Procedures Article 41.

> 2019 SMAC HEALTH SURVEY

- Survey was sent out to all member schools administrators for completion regarding health and safety at their school.
- 78% completed the survey
 - o 92% completed were by the Athletic Director or Athletic Trainer
 - 99% of respondents has at least one AED on site
- Higher percentage rate of completion from the small schools (1A-3A)

> <u>AZ ATHLETIC TRAINER INITIATIVE</u>

- The Arizona Athletic Trainer Initiative was provided another opportunity during the Arizona Cardinals game and the 50/50 Raffle to raise funds for the initiative.
 - \circ $\;$ This was the 3^{rd} opportunity for the Az AT Initiative
 - \$143,330 was raised during the game Initiative will receiving \$71,665

➢ <u>MENTAL HEALTH</u>

- Leagues are looking at screening, post injury, suicide, prevention, possible treatments surrounding mental health.
- Strategies to help address high school athletes mental health have been discussed
- AzATA have an 8 hour training at symposium (30 ATs took the course during the summer and 30 will take in the winter)
