

BASKETBALL 2007 AIA 1A-5A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP RESULTS

PHOENIX, AZ (March 7, 2007) – The Arizona Interscholastic Association would like to congratulate Fredonia (1A Girls), Gilbert Surrey Garden (1A Boys), Tucson Pusch Ridge (2A Girls), Chandler Valley Christian (2A Boys), Ganado (3A Girls), Fountain Hills (3A Boys), Phoenix Washington (4A D-II Girls), and Scottsdale Notre Dame (4A D-II Boys), Glendale Cactus (4A D-I Girls), Glendale Apollo (4A D-I Boys), Tolleson (5A D-II Girls), Scottsdale Desert Mountain (5A D-II Boys), Mesa Red Mountain (5A D-I Girls), and Mesa Mountain View (5A D-I Boys), 2007 AIA State Basketball Champions.

Fredonia defeated Salt River, 50-35, to win the girls title, and Surrey Garden won 74-53 over Phoenix Valley Lutheran to take home the boys championship. Pusch Ridge won the girls 2A title with a 46-36 win over Camp Verde, and Valley Christian defeated Tucson Desert Christian, 63-38, to win back to back 2A boys championships. In 3A, Ganado defeated Winslow, 62-52, to win the girls title, and Fountain Hills won 53-41 over Payson to claim the boys championship. The 4A Division I championships saw the Cactus girls defeat the Pinnacle Girls 65-56, and the Apollo boys won 61-48 over the Tucson Ironwood Ridge boys. In the 4A D-II championships games, the Washington girls won the championship with a 60-47 win over the Page girls and the Notre Dame boys defeated the Tucson Santa Rita boys, 61-56. In 5A, Tolleson won 52-29 over Tolleson Westview to win the girls 5A Division II title, Desert Mountain won the boys 5A Division II championship, 65-55, over Paradise Valley, Red Mountain defeated Mesa Mountain View, 46-34, to win the 5A Division I girls title, and Mountain View claimed the 5A Division I boys championship with a 78-60 win over Phoenix St. Mary's.
