MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Who can compete at the AIA Spiritline State Qualifiers and State Championship?
 - AIA member schools' VARSITY Spiritline teams ONLY
- What is the cost to compete at the AIA Spiritline State Qualifiers and State Championship?
 - Entry fee for both is FREE for AIA member schools
- Can we choose which AIA State Qualifier we compete at?
 - NO. The State Qualifiers have specific conferences set up for equality and consistency.
- Do we have to compete with the same routine at both the State Qualifier level and the State level?
 - NO. You should perform a routine at the State Qualifier level that will qualify you for the State level, and then make improvements for the State Championship. (This may mean a complete new routine or making corrections to the current routine.)
- Do we have to compete at the AIA State Qualifier in order to compete at the State Championship?
 - YES. Teams must qualify at the State Qualifier level in order to compete at the State Championship. A team CANNOT compete at the State Championship if 1). They do not compete at the State Qualifier level or 2). They do not qualify for the State Championship at the State Qualifier level.
- If we compete in Show Cheer ONLY at the State Qualifier level and qualify to compete at the State level, can we compete in other categories other than Show Cheer at the State level?
 - NO. You can only compete at the State level in the categories that you qualified for at the State Qualifier level.
- Do we need to have a waiver signed by all the participants?
 - NO. The school medical forms for all the participants, which you should have on your person at all times, are sufficient. You can find all the necessary forms for the State Qualifiers and the State Championship on our website at www.aiaonline.org under "Activities" and "Spiritlines".
- Can I FAX the forms instead of EMAILING them?
 - ALL FORMS MUST BE TYPED
 - ALL the registration forms need to be EMAILED to mstaples@aiaonline.org.
 - The Participant Eligibility Forms and Coach's Agreement Form need to also be FAXED to AIA at 602-385-3781.

- What if I need to make a change on a registration form?
 - Refax a revised version and write “REVISED” somewhere on the form(s)

- What if I change my music for the State Championship?
 - You will need to fill out a new ASCAP/BMI Music Form and email it to me with a notation that it is a “REVISION”.

- Can Coed Division teams compete in All-Girl Stunt?
 - NO. Coed Division teams who choose to compete in Partner Stunt CANNOT compete in All-Girl Stunt. (All-Girl Stunt is NOT a category for the Coed Division)

- Do we have to compete in all the required categories for the Overall Award at the State Qualifier level to qualify for the Overall Award at the State Championship?
 - YES. You must qualify in each required category for the Overall Award at the State Qualifier level in order to be eligible to compete for the Overall Award at the State level.

- Do you have small, medium or large divisions?
 - NO. We have aligned the Spiritline divisions with the AIA sports divisions. (i.e.: 3A, 4A I, 4A II, etc)

- How do we know if our registration has been received?
 - We will send a confirmation email when the registrations are received. This email will also state any paperwork that is missing.

- Do I have to register again if I qualify for the State Championship?
 - No, your registration for the State Qualifier is suffice. Although, if you make any changes then you will need to FAX those changes to the AIA at 602-385-3781. (NOTE: We do NOT need a new form if you move an alternate up to a main member.)

- When will we know a timeline of the competitions?
 - We will post timelines weekly beginning the week after the registration deadline. You can check our website at www.aiaonline.org under “Activities” and “Spiritlines” for more details.

- Will the teams be able to watch all of the performances at the State Qualifiers?
 - Yes, we have the State Qualifiers at high schools this year that can hold the spectators and the team participants in the gym at the same time.

- Where can I find copies of the judges score sheets?
 - You can find score sheets and other important information on our website at www.aiaonline.org under “Activities” and “Spiritlines”.

- Where can I find the results from the competitions?
 - Results will be posted on our website at www.aiaonline.org under “Activities” and “Spiritlines” the week after the competition ends. Team score sheets and scores of all teams will be mailed to each participating school the week following the competition.
