FREEPORT-McMoRan TO PROVIDE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR NFHS COACH EDUCATION PROGRAM

PHOENIX, AZ (March 4, 2008) – The Arizona Interscholastic Association (AIA) is pleased to announce a partnership with the Freeport-McMoRan Copper and Gold Foundation to provide scholarships for coaches taking the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) “Fundamentals of Coaching” course in Prescott, Bagdad and the communities of Greenlee and Graham Counties

Since being launched in January 2007 the NFHS Coach Education program has become the gold standard for coach education in this country with over 18,000 coaches successfully completing the course. Currently, 39 states and the District of Columbia have adopted “Fundamentals of Coaching” to satisfy their coaching requirements or have agreed to endorse and promote the course.
