Mr. Schmidt explained the committee's focus - how the AIA operates with the officials Topics of discussion:

- Arizona is the only state association in the country that assigns officials to all team sports
- Over 165,000 game assignments last year
- Officials' concerns game fees competition from charter schools & Pop Warner, registration fee increases, cost of background checks and finger print clearance
- Article 18 and Officials Handbook making sure these documents provide appropriate structure for the business of officials...
- Fees market analysis (within Arizona)
- Mileage current state and federal reimbursement amounts
- RefPay operation and cost savings to membership

After a great deal of discussion, the committee determined the following action items for the next meeting:

- Survey all AIA officials questions TBD
- Game fee increase show what school's increase would look like (example \$5 increase)
- Data games/percentage of individual official's assignments
- Data retention of officials
- Data RefPay what schools are currently paying
- Discussion Article 18 Officials
