➤ NFHS FOOTBALL RULES UPDATE (Javier Cardenas)

- New rule for Targeting (attempt to strike a player about the shoulders)
- Onside kicks are limited to a specific number of players on a given side.
- Officials department will share the date for onside kicks at the next meeting.

SKIN INFECTIONS IN WRESTLING (Chuck Schmidt & Javier Cardenas)

- The AIA moved forward in a swift manner when informed with several schools having wrestlers with skin lesions.
- The AIA contacted Dr. Javier Cardenas, Wrestling Coaches Association, as well as other medical personnel and the CDC.
- Moved forward with a stricter protocol for skin checks.
 - o Officials will no longer be involved with skin checks, only MD, DO, NP or PAC.
 - o If the appropriate healthcare professional finds a skin lesion the athlete will not be allowed to participate.
- Looking at the steps to monitor throughout the year Dr. Kristina Wilson suggested having the athletes pre-treated. The cost is very affordable.

> CONCUSSION BASELINE TESTING
