No Stacking Rule in Team Competition

Beach volleyball pairs in team competition shall compete with pairs on the opposing team with the same skill rank. Player movement within the team lineup is restricted to one position up or down from one event (duel or tournament) to another.

Example: Team competes in a duel in which player A plays in the #2 pair. During the next event that the team competes in, Player A may only compete in the #1, #2, #3 pair.

When a regular team member is unable to participate in her established position, that position shall be filled by inserting a substitute or advancing all team members, whether they be varsity, junior varsity or freshman. In subsequent events, when the replaced team member returns, she must return to the position she last played. When a regular pair is unable to participate in their established position, that position shall be filled by advancing all other pairs, whether they be varsity, junior varsity or freshman.

Example: #1 pair unable to compete. Pair #2 moves to the #1 rank competition, #3 moves to the #2 rank competition, #4 moves to the #3 rank competition, #5 moves to the #4 rank competition, #6 alternate pair moves to the #5 rank competition.

Example: Player A on the #2 pair unable to compete. Option 1: Alternate A moves to the #2 pair to replace the player unable to compete. Option 2: a player from pair #3 moves to pair #2, a player from pair #4 moves to pair #3, a player from pair #5 moves to pair #5.
