From Brian Gessner:

Time between games in Stadiums-

AIA personnel will be working to minimize time between games while allowing for field prep and proper warm up.

• Non-game personnel in dugouts

Always a concern for umpires; especially non-coaching adults – should not be the case during the regular season; definitely not permitted during State Tournament.

- Pace of Play- Pitch Clock, Non-coach mound visits NFHS Point of Emphasis; 20 sec limit between pitches.
- Run Rules

After discussion, Baseball SAC voted (7-0; 3 abstentions) to request of the AIA Executive Board for the 2023 season: With the agreement of both schools participating, a baseball game shall end any time after four innings or after three and one-half (3-1/2) innings when a team is fifteen or more runs behind and has completed its turn at bat.

• Sub Varsity Time Limits

After discussion, Baseball SAC voted (8-1) to request of the AIA Executive Board for the 2023 season: <u>Time Limit</u> – A non-varsity baseball game shall be limited to 2 hours. The team currently batting may conclude their at bat. • Base coaches wearing helmets

After discussion, Baseball SAC voted (9-0) to request of the AIA Executive Board for the 2023 season: A coach in a coach's box must wear a helmet.

- Coaches and players outside of the dugout during play NFHS Point of Emphasis safety.
- Extended dugouts

This can be applied to an area toward the outfield; clarified at pre-game meeting.

From Garye LaFevers:

- Pitch Count
 - Much concern with forfeits in the State Tournament each of the last two years.
 - SAC discussed having an extra umpire to chart PC during regular season and post season (If extra umpires were available, this cost would start at a minimum of \$10,000)
 - After additional discussion, SAC recommends:
 - AIA Pitch Count Document be upgraded to show all pitchers on both teams and highlighted markings noting additional "days off."
 - Home team will designate the <u>official</u> PC tracker in Home dugout.
 - Home and Away teams will confer on PC each inning.
 - AD of Home team (or designee) will enter PC for BOTH teams on school AIA dashboard by 10 am the next day.
 - ADs of both schools receive "red flag" email if PC is not entered by 10 am the next day.
