RULES: National Federation Wrestling Rule Book
WEIGHT CLASSES: 102lbs, 109lbs, 116lbs, 122lbs, 128lbs, 134lbs, 140lbs, 147lbs, 154lbs, 167, 187lbs, 237lbs
FORMAT: Sixteen-person bracket – double elimination.

SEEDING CRITERIA: **Wrestlers Must Have a Winning Record to be Seeded.**

1. Minimum of 7 matches overall to be seeded. Forfeits do NOT count to meet minimum number of matches
2. Returning previous year's Arizona State Placer
3. Overall season win%
 - o Multiple undefeated with no other criteria, higher seed goes to most wins
4. Trackwrestling will consider all common opponents to determine seeding
5. Head-to-Head will supersede #1, #3, and #4

WEIGH-INS: 9:00 am on Saturday, February 3rd
Main Gym/O.K. Fulton Gym in the back hallway and locker room

Only NFHS Wrestling Skin Lesion forms will be accepted, and they MUST be dated within the previous 7 days unless it is for non-contagious skin condition like eczema or psoriasis.

MATCH TIMES: Championship matches 2-2-2
Consolation matches 1-2-2
Overtime matches will be per Federation Rules

OFFICIALS: AIA officials will be assigned to the tournament

TOURNAMENT SCORING:

1 st place	16 Points
2 nd place	12 Points
3 rd place	9 Points
4 th place	7 Points

AWARDS: Medals to top four placers
Sectional Championship Team Award
Top four placers qualify for the AIA State Tournament

WRISTBANDS: No one but athletes, coaches, and workers will be allowed on the floor at any time. Head Coaches will be given 3 wristbands each.

TABLE WORKERS: Table workers will be provided by the tournament site.

PHOTOS/VIDEOS: **NO photo or video personnel of any kind will be allowed on the floor at anytime, except for the designated award ceremony.**

LOCKERS: **No locker rooms provided this year except for weigh ins.**
