Seeding Criteria	<p>Wrestlers Must Have a Winning Record to be Seeded</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum of 4 matches overall to be seeded • Returning Previous Year's Arizona State Placer • Overall Season Win% <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Multiple undefeated with no other criteria high seed goes to most wins • TrackWrestling will consider all common opponents to determine seeding • Head-to-Head will supersede #1, #3, and #4

Officials	Certified AIA officials will be assigned to the tournament
