General Rules for Sectional Meets & State Championship

All rules as stated in the National Federation Rules Book for this sport, along with the AIA Constitution & Bylaws as well as these tournament instructions apply.

- 1. <u>Bicycles will not be allowed</u> on the sectional courses as well as on the state championship course. Neither coaches nor those associated with a team are to ride bicycles as it can create an unfair advantage.
- 2. <u>Spikes are not allowed</u> on the sectional courses or the state championship course.
- 3. Per AIA Policy 24.10.5.1 The use of unmanned aerial systems, often referred to as drones, is prohibited for any purpose by any person at all AIA post-season events.

All changes must be completed prior to race time with the Wingfoot Finish Timing tent.

Sectional BIB Instructions for Coaches

- 1. Inspect your team packet to ensure you received all your bibs
 - a. Immediately notify meet management if you are missing any bibs.
 - b. Very important this must be done before leaving the packet pickup area.
- 2. Distribute your bibs to all competing athletes
 - a. All athletes must wear their assigned bib, as assigned on your team roster.
 - b. Athletes that are not registered should not use someone else's bib.
 - c. Failure to properly distribute the bibs will result in inaccurate results.
- 3. Athletes must properly secure their bibs with the three provided safety pins

State Qualifying Standards

- Each Sectional race will qualify the <u>top 50%</u> of FULL (5 or more runners) teams that finish with a team score. If a Section has an odd number of scoring teams the number of qualifying teams will be rounded up. Example: 11 Sectional teams scoring in the results will qualify 6 teams for state.
- Each Sectional race will qualify the <u>top 7 individual finishers</u> from teams that are NOT qualifying as one of the top 50% of full teams that finish with a team score as referenced above.
 - **Appeals:** All appeals must be processed through the Meet Referee. No appeals will be processed on judgment calls made by a meet official. The Meet Referee will be the final authority on rule infractions.
