Accessing the AIA Dashboard

-Log into your aiaonline.org account - must be the account/email your AD used in the Dashboard

-If you are a new coach, work with your AD to obtain access.

-Assistant coaches who created an account for the exam/course will not have access to register.

Note - A choreographer/skills coach may only register with one team. If more than one team registers the same name, the team who registered the name of the choreographer/skills coach first (registration is time stamped) will be the team that person is permitted with.

Having Issues? Check these things...

The option to register is not showing up when I log-in...

You *must* use the account/email that is in the Dashboard. It should be the same email your AD entered into the Dashboard and that you receive official AIA emails too. If you created a separate account where you took the exam/course, you will not see the option to register. Email Emily and Annie. State your name & school and that you need took the exam/course on a different account. We should be able to merge them together.

Your assistant coach(es) are not there to add to your registration...

That means they did not take the NFHS Exam and/or the Online Course. The link to those instructions are on slide 5. It could also mean they did not select your school when they enrolled into the course.

But I was able to add my assistant coach to the Game Day registration, why are they not showing up now?

In the first few days of Game Dayr registration being open, we realized it was allowing assistant coaches to be added who took just the exam and/or the course, not both. We fixed the glitch, but allowed those assistant coaches to stay registered to avoid confusion. For Traditional registration, the system will NOT allow a coach to be added who has not take both the NFHS Exam and the Online Course. Again, see slide 5 for the link to those requirements.
